PRAAT Guide

Step 1 - How to Download Praat

- 1. Go to your web browser, and type in "<u>www.praat.org</u>"
- 2. Go to the box on the left that says "Download Praat"; click according to what program you have (i.e. Windows, Macintosh, etc.)
- Then you will have the choice to click on one of the following 32-bit edition: praat6153_win32.zip 64-bit edition: praat6153_win64.zip (Older computers should use 32-bit, newer 64-bit)
- 4. Click on the 32 or 64-bit zip file.
- 5. Once the folder has downloaded onto your toolbar, click on it.
- 6. Click "Run" when the file appears on your screen.

Step 2 - How to Record with Praat

- 1. Once PRAAT opens, close the right tab ("Praat Picture"). Then move your cursor over the left window ("Praat Objects"), and click "New."
- Then click "Record mono sound..." to record. (Ignore other options like sampling frequency, etc.)
- 3. Once you have finished your recording, click "Stop"
- 4. In the bottom, right hand corner, there is a box that says "Name" on the new window. Click it, and erase "untitled."
- Write your last name, underscore, and the date (MonthDay), i.e.
 Offerman_0903 (September = 09; 3rd=03)

Step 3 - How to Save with Praat

- 1. Click "Save to list and close"
- 2. Go back to the window that says "Praat Objects"
- 3. Click on the title of your recording (i.e. Smith_0903)
- 4. Go to "Save" at the top
- 5. Go down to where it says "Save as WAV file" (4th option) and click; you may save this in whatever location you choose, but pick somewhere that you'll remember (My Documents, Desktop, etc; it should look like Smith_0903.wav).
 - a. DO NOT RECORD AND SAVE TO YOUR PHONE!! This type of sound file will NOT work!!
- 6. Once you have finished, please remember where you have saved your files, then send them to the designated GMAIL account.
- *Please also have your recordings ready to open on the designated days of class.
